
LIVE EDGE – STRING ART JUNIOR WOODWORK PROJECT

MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT LIST:

- Tape Measure
- Clamps
- Coping saw
- Hand saw
- Hammer

- Screwdrivers
- Sanding block
- Assorted string/wire/pipe cleaners
- Assorted small nails / or screws
- ✤ Variety of Tree branches 3-5" in diameter
- 1. Gather Materials:



2. From the end of your material, measure and mark a line 1" from the end. – You will probably need to use a sharpie to ensure you can see the cut line.




3. Secure your material with clamps to your work bench and begin carefully cutting.




4. Once through your material, sand any rough edges using your sanding block.



5. Using a pencil draw your chosen design onto your wood slice.






6. With your hammer, carefully place your nails. They should be evenly spaced. – Do not go all the way through your material. The heads should stick out from your wood slice approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ "




7. Once all your nails are securely in place, you can begin wrapping your string or wire.



8. Continue wrapping your material around each nail head, be sure to pull the wire/string tight so it stays in place.



9. Once you have completed your wrapping, be sure to trim any loose ends and secure them to your project. – A dab of hot glue is often helpful with this step.



10. Display your finished products for all to see
