As a Medical Lab Assistant, you will perform pre-analysis and pre-testing tasks such as collecting blood and other samples, processing specimens, and preparing special chemicals for use in testing. You will set up, clean and maintain lab equipment and conduct routine medical lab tests. Medical Lab Assistants work in hospitals, clinics, research facilities, post-secondary institutions and government research laboratories.
