

Career Exploration Activities



Four Corners

Label the 4 corners of your room. Ask a question aloud, and have students move to the corner that best represents their opinion.

***Refer to the Career Discussion Questions poster for prompts**

Once there, they can discuss their reasoning with others in the same corner, and then share with the whole group

Think-Pair-Share

Watch a couple of videos & ask a question or pose a scenario for students to think about individually, then pair up with a classmate to share their ideas. ***Refer to the Career Discussion Questions poster for prompts**

Then have students switch partners & share again, to create a rotating conversation to help students hear multiple perspectives.

Career Research

Assign students subject-related careers to research and present.

Topics could include required skills, necessary education or training, typical work environments, and notable contributions by people in these fields ***Refer to the Career Discussion Questions poster for prompts**



Career Pathway Posters

Have students create pathway posters for a chosen career, illustrating the educational steps, skills required, and possible career trajectories.

Display these around the classroom or school for other students to see and/or have the students present their findings.
